The Father Saves

2Peter 3:

9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing (intending) that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

It is not God's intention that anyone be lost but that all would be saved into His kingdom. This is why I believe there must be a giving of the message of God's love before the 2nd coming of Christ.

1Corinthians 2

1 And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony (evidence given) of God.

2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

The point of Paul's preaching was to declare the character of the Father. He did it using Christ and Him crucified.

JESUS

Matthew 1

20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

Jesus G2424 = H3091 Ye-ho-shoo-ah (YHVH Saved)

When the Son of God made the decision to save us from our sins He became Yehowshuwa (Joshua)

Philippians 2

5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus (Yehowshuwa):

6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

7 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus (Yehowshuwa) Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Ephesians 3

9 And to make all men see what is the fellowship (joint participation) of the mystery (of God's love), which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created (the whole 1:10) all things by Jesus (Yehowshuwa) Christ:

This is not speaking of literal creation but inward creation as described in Genesis 1 and 2.

Isaiah 53

1 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed?
2 For he shall grow up (H5927 "ascend up") before him as a tender plant (H3126 "a twig of a tree felled and sprouting"), and as a root out of a dry ground (Compare 2Corinthians 8:9): he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.
