

# 1Corinthians 1

Monday, October 22, 2012

## Romans 11

36 For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: to whom be glory for ever. Amen.

**Out of Him - through Him - back to Him. Christ brings us back to the Father.**

## Acts 17

26 And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath **determined** <G3724 - to mark out -Luke 22:22> the times <G2540 - Fitting opportunity - 1x> **before appointed** <G4384 - set in order, appoint before>, and the bounds <G3734 - limits - 1x> of their habitation;

27 That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might **feel after him, and find him**, though he be not far from every one of us:

## Ephesians 3

14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

**We are empowered to forgive others and to live without condemnation when the spirit of the Father dwells within.**

17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, 18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God.

20 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

21 Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

## Isaiah 59

20 And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the Lord.

21 As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the Lord; My spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the Lord, from henceforth and for ever. 60

1 Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee.

2 For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

3 And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

4 Lift up thine eyes round about, and see: all they gather themselves together, they come to thee: thy sons shall come from far, and thy daughters shall be nursed at thy side.

1 Corinthians 1

1 Paul, called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God, and Sosthenes our brother,

2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called ~~to~~ **be saints <G40 - holy>**, with all that in every place (of life) call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

**Called holy ones!**

**Compare Ephesians 4:30** And grieve not the **holy (one) <G40 - holy>**, Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

Hebrews 9:2 For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the shewbread; which is called the **sanctuary <G39 - holy place>**.

**The Saints possess the mind of God and the sanctuary is the outward expression of the inward truth.**

3 Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 1

**2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,**

**There is no graciousness or peace realized without having a knowledge of truth.**

**God's graciousness is there but we just can't see it without a knowledge of Christ.**

4 I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ;

5 That **in every thing** ye are enriched by him, **in all utterance, and in all knowledge;**

6 Even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you:

**It is the testimony of Christ that brings the riches of God.**

7 So that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the **coming <G602 - Revelation>** of our Lord Jesus Christ:

**His revealing to the world!**

8 Who shall also confirm you unto the end, ~~that ye may be~~ blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

**This is also seen in Revelation 6 in each of the seals, or confirmations! In each position taken we were blameless in God's eyes.**

9 God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

10 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

**This verse could not be a reality if verse two were not a reality.**

11 For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them which are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you.

12 Now this I say, that every one of you saith, I am of Paul; and I of Apollos; and I of Cephas; and I of Christ.

13 Is Christ divided? was Paul crucified for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul?

14 I thank God that I baptized none of you, but Crispus and Gaius;

15 Lest any should say that I had baptized in mine own name.

16 And I baptized also the household of Stephanas: besides, I know not whether I baptized any other.

17 For Christ sent me not to baptize (immerse), but to preach (immerse in the water of the word) the gospel: not with wisdom of words, **lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect.**
