

Of the Mind - Spiritual

Genesis 26

35 Which were a grief of **mind (h7307 - spirit)** unto Isaac and to Rebecca.

Ezekiel 20

32 And that which cometh into your **mind (h7306 - spirit)** shall not be at all, that ye say, We will be as the heathen, as the families of the countries, to serve wood and stone.

Proverbs 29

11 A fool uttereth all his **mind (h7307 - spirit)**: but a wise man keeps it in till afterwards.

Ephesians 3

14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and -- earth is named,

16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by **his Spirit in the inner man**;

Romans 7

22 For I delight in the law of God after the **inward man**:

23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law **of my mind**, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

If spirit = mind then spiritual means of the mind.

Zechariah 12

1 The burden of the word of the Lord for Israel, saith the Lord, which **stretches forth the heavens, and lays the foundation of the earth, and forms the spirit of man within him.**

Romans 2

26 Therefore if the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision?

27 And shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfill the law, judge thee, who by the letter and circumcision dost transgress the law?

28 For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh:

29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and **circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit**, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.

Colossians 2

10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the **circumcision made without hands**, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:

12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

Revelation 12

12 Therefore rejoice, **ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the**

earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

Revelation 21

1 And I saw a new **heaven and a new earth**: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was **no more sea**.

The work of God is spiritual, or of the mind.

Matthew 24

14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the **end (g5056 - the point aimed at)** come.

The gospel of the kingdom is given by the last generation church to the gentiles in Revelation chapters 8-9, to the Jew in Revelation chapter 11, and to the world by the Jews in Revelation chapter 16.

The preaching of the gospel brings God's people to completion, it does not bring the end of the world.

15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand (remain) in the holy place, (whoso reads, let him understand (consider):

16 Then let them which be in Judea flee into the mountains (of Israel):

17 Let him which is on the housetop not come down to **take any thing out of his house**:

18 Neither let him which is in the field return back **to take his clothes**.

If God changes our foundation of belief then there is nothing we have believed that is accurate.

19 And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!

20 But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:

The feasts of Leviticus 16 point to spiritual events that happen to each believer individually. The winter and sabbath happened after the feasts.

The winter and sabbath point to the end when the host of God are made complete.

21 For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

The tribulation of the wicked will be at it's height when the righteous have come to the fullness of God's love.

22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

23 Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not.

24 For there shall arise false Christ's, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

25 Behold, I have told you before.

26 Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; believe it not.

27 For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shines even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

28 For wheresoever the carcass is, there will the eagles be gathered together.

29 Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:

Psalms 46

2 Therefore will not we fear, **though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;**

3 Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah.

30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

31 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.
