

AN EXALTED PLACE

SPEAK TO THE HEART

Isaiah 40:1-2 KJV

- 1) *Comfort ye, comfort ye my people, saith your God.*
- 2) *Speak ye comfortably (h5921 – to the heart) to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare (h6635 – Host) is accomplished (h4390 – made full), that her iniquity is pardoned (h7521 – made favorable, reconciled): for she hath received of the LORD'S hand **double for all her sins.***

Ephesians 1:3-5 KJV

3) *Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:*

4) *According (g2531 – inasmuch) as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:*

5) *Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,*

If these truths equal all blessings of the mind, we should be able to reach the fullness of God's love by believing them.

Before the foundation of the world, God predestinated us unto adoption of children thru Christ, that we may be holy and without blame before Him in Love.

Isaiah 61:7 KJV

7) *For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them.*

Zechariah 9:12 KJV

12) *Turn you to the strong hold, ye prisoners of hope: even to day do I declare that I will render double unto thee;*

Revelation 18:6 KJV

6) *Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double.*

TWO BURNING THINGS

Isaiah 6:1-7 KJV

- 1) In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. Cf. John 12:41
- 2) Above it stood the seraphims (h8314 – Burning things): each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.
- 3) And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: [the whole earth is full of his glory]. **ML: the fullness of the earth is His glory.**
- 4) And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke.
- 5) Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.
- 6) Then flew one of the seraphims (h8314 – Burning things) unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar:
- 7) And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is **taken away (h5493 – turned off)**, and thy sin **purged (h3722 – covered)**.

TWO MESSENGERS

Exodus 25:17-22 KJV

- 17) And thou shalt make a mercy seat of pure gold: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof.
- 18) And thou shalt make two cherubims of gold, of beaten work shalt thou make them, in the two ends of the mercy seat. (Cf. Romans 3:25, Christ is the mercy seat)
Romans 3:25 KJV
 - 25) Whom God hath set forth to be a **propitiation (g2435 – mercy seat)** through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;
- 19) And make one cherub on the one end, and the other cherub on the other end: even of the mercy seat shall ye make the cherubims on the two ends thereof.
- 20) And the cherubims shall stretch forth their wings on high, covering the mercy seat with their wings, and their faces shall look one to another; toward the mercy seat shall the faces of the cherubims be.
- 21) And thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee.
- 22) And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.

SONS OF OIL

Zechariah 4:11-14 KJV

- 11) Then answered I, and said unto him, What are these two olive trees upon the right side of the candlestick and upon the left side thereof?
- 12) And I answered again, and said unto him, What be these two olive branches which through the two golden pipes empty the golden oil out of themselves?
- 13) And he answered me and said, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord.
- 14) Then said he, These are the two anointed ones (SONS OF OIL), that stand by (h5921 – Above, upon) the Lord of the whole earth.

Revelation 11:1-14 KJV

- 1) And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.
- 2) But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months (6x7 – or until wickedness is perfected).
- 3) And I will give ~~power~~ **(understanding)** unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.
3x10x7x6 a complete understanding of the fullness of man
- 4) These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.
- 5) And if any ~~man~~ **(one)** will hurt (q91 – be unjust) them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any ~~man~~ **(one)** will hurt (q91 – be unjust) them, he must in this manner be killed. (YLT: "it behooves him to be killed")
He must be killed by fire. Remember the fire of the last day. When the two witnesses give their testimony the Lord is very near to come.
- 6) These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.
- 7) And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.
- 8) And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.
- 9) And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.
- 10) And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.
- 11) And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.
- 12) And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.
- 13) And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain **(names)** of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted (q1719 – alarmed), and gave glory to the God of heaven.
- 14) The second woe is past; and, behold, the third woe cometh quickly.
