

Scarcely Saved

Abrahamic Covenant

Gen 12:1-3 KJV

1) Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

2) And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:

3) And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Gen 13:14-17 KJV

14) And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward:

15) For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.

16) And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered.

17) Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee.

Gen 15:1-6 KJV

1) After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.

2) And Abram said, Lord GOD, what wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house is this Eliezer of Damascus?

3) And Abram said, Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir.

4) And, behold, the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir.

5) And he brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be.

6) **And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.**

Rom 4:8-13 KJV

8) Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.

9) Cometh this blessedness then upon the circumcision only, or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness.

10) How was it then reckoned? when he was in circumcision, or in uncircumcision? Not in circumcision, but in uncircumcision.

11) **And he received the sign (g4592-token) of circumcision, a seal (g4973-confirmation) of the righteousness of the faith which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also:**

12) *And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which he had being yet uncircumcised.*

13) *For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.*

Gen 17:1-11 KJV

1) *And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect.*

2) *And I will make my **covenant** between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly.*

3) *And Abram fell on his face: and God talked with him, saying,*

4) *As for me, behold, my **covenant** is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations.*

5) *Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.*

6) *And I will make thee exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of thee, and kings shall come out of thee.*

7) *And I will establish my **covenant** between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting **covenant**, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee.*

8) *And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.*

9) *And God said unto Abraham, Thou shalt keep my **covenant** therefore, thou, and thy seed after thee in their generations.*

10) ***This is my **covenant****, which ye shall keep, between me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised (h4135 to cut short, that is, curtail)*

11) ***And** ye shall circumcised (h4135) the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the **covenant** betwixt me and you.*

CF:

Jer 4:4 KJV

4) *Circumcise (h4135) yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings.*

Col 2:11 KJV

11) *In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision **made without hands**, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:*

Gal 3:16 KJV

16) *Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ.*

Gal 3:29 KJV

29) *And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.*

Believing God

Heb 11:17-19 KJV

17) *By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son,*

18) *Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be called:*

19) *Accounting that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.*

1Pe 4:17-18 KJV

17) *For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?*

18) *And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear?*

By the time of the end God's church will have entered into the fullness and will be reflecting the image of Christ. For the righteous to "scarcely be saved" is speaking of their physical lives not the salvation of their souls.

2Pe 3:10-13 KJV

10) *But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.*

11) *Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, **what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness,***

12) *Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?*

13) *Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.*

Luke 21:25-26 KJV

25) *And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring;*

26) *Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken.*

2Th 1:6-8 KJV

6) *Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you;*

7) *And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels,*

8) *In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:*

Fires of vengeance belong to man, not God.

Mat 24:22 KJV

22) *And except those days should be shortened, **there should no flesh be saved:** but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.*

For all intents and purposes the last generation church would be considered dead much like Isaac when Abraham offered him a sacrifice to God. Only hope in God and Christ will give us boldness to stand in that day.
