

The Path of the Just

The Transfiguration

Matthew 17:1-9 KJV

- 1) *And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,*
- 2) *And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.*
- 3) *And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him.*
- 4) *Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.*
- 5) *While he yet spoke, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.*
- 6) *And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid.*
- 7) *And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid.*
- 8) *And when they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no man, save Jesus only.*
- 9) *And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, Tell the vision to no man, until the Son of man be risen again from the dead.*

From Darkness to Light

2 Peter 1:16-21 KJV

- 16) *For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty.*
- 17) *For he received from God the Father honor and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.*
- 18) *And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount.*
- 19) *We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:*
- 20) *Knowing this first that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation.*
- 21) *For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.*

Proverbs 4:18-19 KJV

- 18) *But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shines more and more unto the perfect day.*
- 19) *The way of the wicked is as darkness: they know not at what they stumble.*

Through the Eyes of Love

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 **BBE (Bible in Basic English)**

- 4) Love is never tired of waiting; love is kind; love has no envy; love has no high opinion of itself, love has no pride;
- 5) Love's ways are ever fair, it takes no thought for itself; it is not quickly made angry, it takes no account of evil;
- 6) It takes no pleasure in wrongdoing, but has joy in what is true;
- 7) Love has the power of undergoing all things, having faith in all things, hoping all things.

1 Corinthians 13:8-13 KJV

- 8) Charity never fails: but whether there be prophecies, they **shall fail (q2673-render idle)**; whether there be tongues, they **shall cease (q3973-stop)**; whether there be knowledge, it shall **vanish away (q2673-render idle)**.
- 9) For we know in part, and we prophesy in part.
- 10) But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part **shall be done away (q2673-render idle)**;
- 11) When I was a child, I spoke as a child; I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.
- 12) For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.
- 13) And now abides faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.

The Warning

Matthew 7:13-15 KJV

- 13) Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leads to destruction, and many there be which go in there at:
- 14) Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leads unto life, and few there be that find it.
- 15) Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Mar 12:10) And have ye not read this scripture; The stone which the builders rejected is become the head of the corner:

Mar 15:28) And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors.

Luk 4:21) And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

Joh 2:22) When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said.

Joh 7:38) He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

Joh 7:42) Hath not the scripture said, That Christ cometh of the seed of David, and out of the town of Bethlehem, where David was?

Joh 10:35) If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken;

Joh 13:18) I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eateth bread with me hath lifted up his heel against me.

Joh 17:12) While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.

Joh 19:24) They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did.

Joh 19:28) After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst.

Joh 19:36) For these things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken.

Joh 19:37) And again another scripture saith, They shall look on him whom they pierced.

Joh 20:9) For as yet they knew not the scripture, that he must rise again from the dead.

Act 1:16) Men *and* brethren, this scripture must needs have been fulfilled, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus.

Act 8:32) The place of the scripture which he read was this, He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; and like a lamb dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth:

Act 8:35) Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus.
