

# The Marriage Supper

## After These Things

**Revelation 19 is the Jewish believers story of what we see happening in Revelation 12.**

*Revelation 19*

*1 And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, **unto the Lord our God:***

*2 For true and righteous are his judgments: **for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.***

*3 And again they said, Alleluia. And **her smoke rose up for ever and ever (into the age of the ages).***

### **Compare Psalms 37:20**

20 But the wicked shall perish, and the enemies of the Lord shall be as the fat of lambs: they shall consume; into smoke shall they consume away. Psalms 37:20 (KJV)

**Psalms 37 should be read and considered putting the righteous and the wicked within your own heart.**

After Babylon falls for an individual they will be seen in the heavens. The fall of Babylon and ascending into the heavens happens together.

The unknown prophecy of Isaiah 59: 20 states:

*20 And **the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the Lord.***

Paul restates this prophecy:

*Romans 11:26*

*26 And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, **There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:***

In other words, Christ will bring the Gentile believers to the fullness of God's love and use them to turn away ungodliness from the Jew who has ears to hear. In verse one **Christ is the Lord our God**, or the God of Israel to the Jew.

*Revelation 19*

*4 And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped **God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia.***

**Just as the Gentile believers have a past (seen in chapters 4-6) so do the Jewish believers. They are beginning to see the Father in a greater light and are honoring the Son even as they honor the Father. John 5:22-23**

*5 And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both **small and great.***

**The voice of Christ. I love the idea of Christ worshipping the Father with us. In the kingdom of God's love, at this time, there are those who receive a greater input of His peace and love than others. Eventually God will be "all in all." 1 Corinthians 15:28**

## The Wife

**Next we hear the voice of the Gentile believers who have reached the fullness:**

*Revelation 19*

*6 And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thundering, saying, Alleluia: **for the Lord God omnipotent reigns.***

*Isaiah 52*

*7 How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publishes peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publishes salvation; that saith unto Zion, **Thy God reigns!***

*8 Thy watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, **when the Lord shall bring again Zion.***

*9 Break forth into joy, sing together, ye waste places of Jerusalem: for the Lord hath comforted his people, **he hath redeemed Jerusalem.***

*10 The Lord hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.*

*11 Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence, touch no unclean thing; go ye out of the midst of her; be ye clean, that bear the vessels of the Lord.*

*12 For ye shall not go out with haste, nor go by flight: for the Lord will go before you; and **the God of Israel will be your reward (or the One who gathers you).***

*Revelation 19*

*7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honor to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and **his wife** hath made herself ready. **(Having ascended out of the lie)***

*8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints. **Speaking of the Jewish believers. The Gentile believers are already clothed with the Sun (Revelation 12:1).***

*Jeremiah 3*

*14 Turn, O backsliding children, saith the Lord; **for I am married unto you:** and I will take you one of a city, and two of a family, **and I will bring you to Zion:***

*15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.*

*Revelation 21*

*9 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee **the bride, the Lamb's wife.***

*10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me that great city, **the holy Jerusalem,** descending out of heaven from God,*

*Isaiah 62*

*5 For as a young man marries a virgin, **so shall thy sons marry thee:** and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall thy God rejoice over thee.*

**Anyone who enters the holy city of New Jerusalem becomes the bride of Christ. God the Father gives the bride to His Son, and His Son to the bride as seen in the following verses.**

Romans 7

4 Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; **that ye should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead**, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.

Revelation 5

1 And I saw **in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book** written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.

6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb as it had been slain**, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

7 And **he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne** .

## The Spirit of the Prophecy

Revelation 19

9 And he saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of **(the)** prophecy.

**It is quite possible John did not know the messenger who had been speaking to him until this point.**

**The testimony of Jesus is the first part of the book of Revelation, book I. This messenger possessed an understanding of the prophecy concerning the Deliverer coming to Zion then to Jacob (Isaiah 59:20).**

11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

**Compare Psalms 45:4**

4 As to Thy majesty--prosper! --ride! Because of **truth, and meekness--righteousness**, And Thy right hand shows Thee fearful things. Psalms 45:4 (YLT)

12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; **and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.**

**Compare Matthew 11:27**

27 All things are delivered unto me of my Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and he to whomsoever the Son will reveal him. Matt 11:27 (KJV)

13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called **The Word of God.**

14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 And out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and **he treads (G3961) the winepress (G3631) of the fierceness (G2372-wrath) and wrath (G3709-anger) of Almighty God.**

16 And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, **KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF**

LORDS.

## The Supper of God

*Revelation 19*

*17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;*

*18 That ye may **eat the flesh of** kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free **(unrestrained)** and bond, both small and great.*

**This is equivalent to what Paul wrote in Ephesians 6:12.**

*12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.  
Eph 6:12 (KJV)*

**We are being made into the image of Christ, who is the image of the invisible God.**

*19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.*

*20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were **cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.***

**There is always a resistance to truth as we are shown our weaknesses.**

*7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that **ascendeth out of the bottomless pit** shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.  
Rev 11:7 (KJV)*

*21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.*
