# ONE MIND

---

## A Message to All

1 Peter 3

8 Finally, be ye all of **one mind (q3675 – understanding)**, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:

Philippians 2

1 If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies,

2 Fulfill ye my joy, that ye be **likeminded (q5426 – same mindset of will, affections, and conscience)**, having the same love, being of **one accord (q4861 – soul)**, of one **mind (q5426)**.

3 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in **lowliness of mind (q5012 – humility)** let each esteem other better than themselves.

4 Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

5 Let this **mind (q5426)** be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not **robbery (q725 – Something to grasp)** to be equal with God:

7 But **made himself of no reputation (q2758 – emptied himself)**, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

19 Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: **but contrariwise blessing**; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.

10 For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile:

11 Let him **eschew (q1578 – avoid)** evil, and do good; let him **seek peace, and ensue it**.

12 For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil.

13 *And who is he that will harm you, if ye be followers of that which is good?*

14 ***But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye:*** *and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled;*

15 *But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:*

16 *Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ.*

17 ***For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing.***

18 *For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:*
