A woman = a city

Revelation 17

18 And the woman which thou sawest is that great city, which reigneth over the kings of the earth.

A city = a mindset, or spirit

Jeremiah 1

18 For, behold, I have made thee this day a defended city, and an iron pillar, and brazen walls against the whole land, against the kings of Judah, against the princes thereof, against the priests thereof, and against the people of the land.

Proverbs 25

28 He that hath no rule over his own spirit is like a city that is broken down, and without walls.

Eyes = Understanding

18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

Spiritual Wickedness

Zechariah 5

5 Then the angel that talked with me went forth, and said unto me, Lift up now thine **eyes (h5869 – eye)**, and see what is this that goeth forth.

6 And I said, What is it? And he said, This is an ephah that goeth forth. He said moreover, This is their **resemblance (h5869 – eye)** through all the earth.

H5869. עֵינַי 'ayin, עֵינַיִם 'eynayim: A feminine noun meaning an eye, a spring, a fountain.

Spiritually, the ephah equals the eyes of their understanding.

7 And, behold, there was lifted up a talent of **lead**: and **this is a woman** that sitteth in the midst of the ephah.

8 And he said, **This is wickedness**. And he cast it into the midst of the ephah (or into the midst of their understanding); and he cast the weight of lead upon the mouth thereof.

9 Then lifted I up mine eyes, and looked, and, behold, there came out two women, and the wind was in their wings; for they had wings like **the wings of a stork**: and they lifted up the ephah between the earth and the heaven.


10 Then said I to the angel that talked with me, Whither do these bear the ephah?

11 And he said unto me, To build it a house in the land of Shinar (h8152 – Babylon): and it shall be established, and set there upon her own base.

H8152. שִׁנְעָר šin'ar: A proper noun designating Shinar, the name of the plain where the city and nation of Babylon were begun by Nimrod (Gen. 10:8–10; 11:2).

Revelation 16

19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

2 Timothy 3

1 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

4 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;


5 **Having a form of godliness, but denying the power (g1411 – ability) of His forgiveness) thereof: from such turn away.**

The Kingdom of God

Matthew 13

33 Another parable spake he unto them; The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which **a woman** took, and hid in **three measures** of meal, till the whole was leavened.

The Kingdom of Heaven = God's understanding



One woman – three understandings

Proverbs 4

18 But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day.

19 The way of the wicked is as darkness: they know not at what they stumble.

Each step taken in God's kingdom equals a four, or earthly completeness, an end of self. There are three fours unto perfection.

Revelation 12

1 And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of **twelve stars**:

12 x 1000 (or many) taken from 12 tribes = 144,000. Those who have reached the fullness of God's love and are made whole in His love.
