1 Corinthians 10:13 KJV

13) *There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man (q442-human): but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.*

Hebrews 4:15 KJV

15) *For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.*

James 1:13 KJV

13) *Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempts he any man:*

John 2:13-17 compares to Psalms 69:1-9...a divine temptation?

Psalms 69:5 KJV

5) *O God, thou knowest my foolishness; and my sins (h819-guiltiness, guilt) are not hid from thee.*

Perfect through Suffering

Hebrews 2:10 KJV

10) *For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.*

Hebrews 2:18 KJV

18) *For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succor them that are tempted.*

Hebrews 5:8-9 KJV

8) *Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered;*

9) *And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;*

Seven Things Spoken

Luke 23:33-34 KJV

33) *And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left.*

34) *Then said Jesus, **Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do.** And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.*

Luke 23:43 KJV

43) *And Jesus said unto him, **Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.***

John 19:26-28 KJV

26) *When Jesus therefore saw his mother, and the disciple standing by, whom he loved, he saith unto his mother, **Woman, behold thy son!***

27) *Then saith he to the disciple, **Behold thy mother!** And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own home.*

Matthew 27:45-47 KJV

45) *Now **from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour.***

46) *And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, **Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?** that is to say, **My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?***

John 19:28 KJV

28) *After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I **thirst.***

John 19:30 KJV

30) *When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, **It is finished:** and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.*

Luke 23:46 KJV

46) *And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, **Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit:** and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.*

Psalms 22

Psalms 22:1-21 KJV

1) **My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?** why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?

2) *O my God, I cry in the daytime, but thou hear not; and in the night season, and am not silent.*

3) *But thou art holy, O thou that inhabits the praises of Israel.*

4) *Our fathers trusted in thee: they trusted, and thou didst deliver them.*

5) *They cried unto thee, and were delivered: they trusted in thee, and were not confounded.*

6) *But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people.*

A worm refers to the "old man". CF: Isaiah 66:24. Christ was made to be sin 2 Corinthians 5:21.

**7) All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying,
8) He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him.**

9) But thou art he that **took (h1518-to gush forth like water)** me out of the womb: thou didst make me hope when I was upon my mother's breasts.

10) I was cast upon thee from the womb: thou art my God from my mother's belly.

11) Be not far from me; for trouble is near; for there is none to help.

12) Many bulls have compassed me: strong bulls of Bashan have beset me round.

13) They gaped upon me with their mouths, as a ravening and a roaring lion.

Psalms 68:22 KJV

22) The Lord said, I will bring again from **Bashan**, I will bring my people again from the **depths of the sea:**

14) I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels.

15) My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaves to my jaws; and thou hast brought me into the dust of death.

16) For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet.

17) I may tell all my bones: they look and stare upon me.

18) They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.

19) But be not thou far from me, O LORD: O my strength, haste thee to help me.

20) Deliver my soul from the sword; my darling (h3173-only one) from the power (h3027-hand) of the dog.

21) Save me from the lion's mouth: for thou hast heard me from the horns (h7161-a projection {of light}) of the unicorns (7214-a high place).

Dogs

Proverbs 26:11 KJV

11) As a dog returns to his vomit, so a fool returns to his folly.

2 Peter 2:19-22 KJV

19) While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.

20) For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.

21) For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.

22) But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.
